

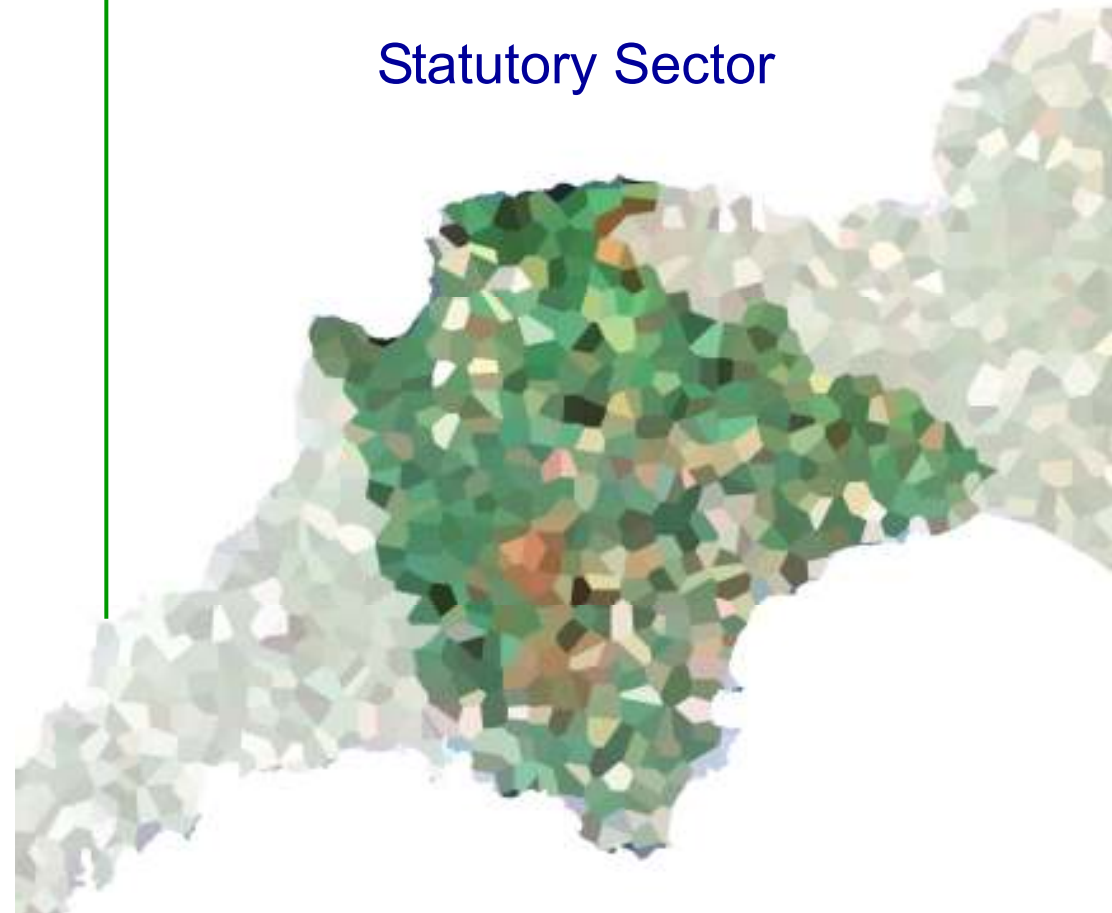

# 10 Things You Need to Know about the Compact for Devon's Consultation Code of Practice

**Do you have contact with the voluntary or  
community sector in Devon?**

**Do you work in partnership with or provide  
funding to voluntary and community organisations  
in Devon?**

**Do you consult with the voluntary and community  
sector on issues of importance?**

**If so ... you need to read this**

1. This Code forms part of the Compact for Devon and aims to have a positive impact on the way in which the statutory sector consults with the voluntary and community sector
2. It sets out the key responsibilities and commitments that each sector has to ensure that consultation exercises deliver the best possible outcomes
3. Consultation should take place where it represents clear and established added value, and where the outcomes of the exercise are genuinely open to influence and change

4. The nature, scale and scope of each consultation exercise will be proportionate to the resources available and the outcomes of the consultation
5. The additional costs to the voluntary and community sector of engaging in consultation will as far as possible be met by those agencies consulting
6. Consultation exercises will be well planned in terms of approach, principles and methods used
7. Who to consult with will be given careful thought in order to be as inclusive as possible, whilst bearing in mind the need to be proactive to genuinely engage hard to reach sections of the community
8. Consultation outcomes will be well publicised
9. Review and evaluation will be built in to all consultation processes
