

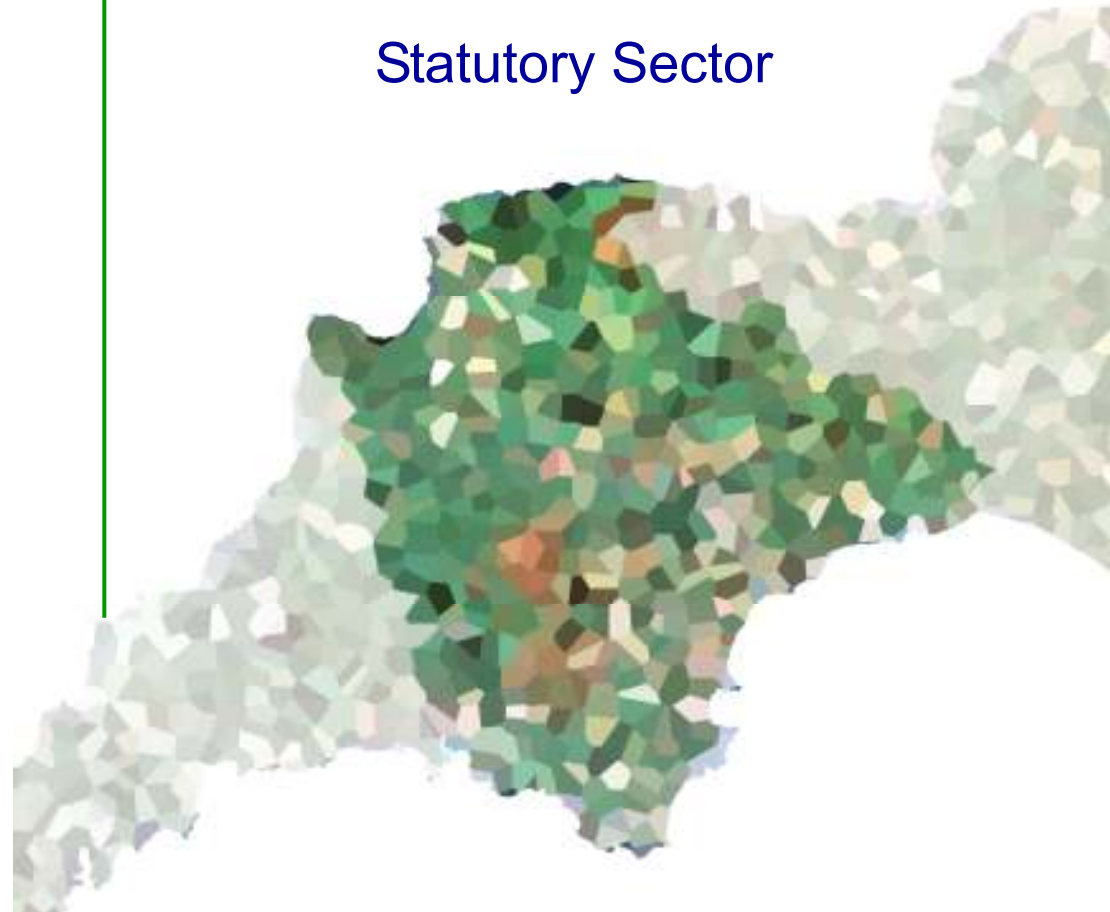

If so ... you need to read this

1. This Code forms part of the Compact for Devon and aims to promote and support the work of the community sector in Devon
2. The Code sets out the key responsibilities and commitments of all those who work with the community sector, and of the community sector itself
3. The community sector in Devon provides a range of services to local people and communities which improve the quality of life and life chances of those communities and people
4. The community sector can represent real value for money

5. The community sector can play a range of different roles including: providing a voice, building relationships and networks, providing self help and mutual support, and delivering services
6. The community sector is generally well placed to understand the needs of local people
7. Developing the capacity of the community sector is beneficial to everyone
8. Community sector organisations have responsibility for operating within the law and along the lines of best practice and sound governance
9. The community sector in Devon operates in a county where rurality presents specific issues and challenges
